CLASSES AT DANCE POWER

LADIES DANCEFIT

This class is for ladies of any fitness level as exercises will be adjusted to meet your needs. You don't need any dance experience to give it a try. Our Mini Groovers preschool dance program is delivered by fully qualified, friendly and passionate dance teachers in a safe, caring and encouraging environment. Your child will have the option of performing their age appropriate dances at our end of year concerts.

- MG Jazz & Acro

An upbeat class that includes both Jazz and Acro. With a major emphasis on fun and creating confident little people, this class is the first stepping stone on your child's dance journey. This class is the perfect way to start developing the co-ordination skills that form technique foundations and are the basics of dance classes. Children are taught safely the basics of acro which will help them develop gross motor skills, as well as stretching and strengthening exercises. This class is not only an introduction to dance but a place to grow, learn and make friends.

BALLET EXAM CLASSES

It is not compulsory for students to do exams when taking a Ballet class. This choice is to be decided between the parent and student. You will be advised if your child is ready to do an exam. If your child is confident and prepared, we strongly suggest your child does sit for their exam. Sitting an exam is beneficial for your child in many ways:

- For students, examinations provide something to strive for, helping children to acquire skills in a structured and disciplined, yet enjoyable way. Students acquire a strong sense of achievement in progression through examination grades.
- For students who want to seek professional careers in dance/teaching sitting exams provide evidence that they are well trained.
- For parents, examinations provide an independent assessment of the standard their child is achieving.
- It also allows a parent to confirm that the child is progressing and that the investment of time and money in dance lessons is worthwhile.

Minimum class enrolment requirements are enforced for some ballet classes and failure to adhere will result in the student not being able to sit their exam.

Grade 2/3- MUST attend 2 other classes per week.

Pre-Elementary & Pointe - MUST attend a LYRICAL and JAZZ class each week.

SELECTED GROUPS

Our selected classes will be our Eisteddfod groups. The purpose of these classes is to have students who are dedicated in achieving a high standard of dance. They are like minded students and families that understand the importance of team work. Our 2024 class timetable is attached to this newsletter and all classes with an *asterisk indicates that students will need to be selected in order to enrol in the class.

Minimum class enrolment requirements are enforced for each selected class:

Selected Jazz- MUST attend 2 other classes per week.

Selected Lyrical- MUST attend 2 other classes per week.

Acro Dancer Wednesday- MUST attend another acro class for development

Hip Hop Crew - MUST attend 1 other Hip Hop Class per week

REGISTRATION FEE

Registration Fees are a one-off payment for each student, each year and are payable when you enrol on our portal.

\$25 flat fee per student (ALL ages) OR \$50 per family

CLASS FEES

\$9 per 30 minute class (\$36 per 4 weeks) \$14.00 per 45 minute class (\$56 per 4 weeks) \$15.00 per 60 minute class (\$60 per 4 weeks)

Mini Groover's and Lil Kidz classes- Half hour class is \$9 (\$36 per 4 weeks) or if you do the two consecutive classes on the SAME day it will be \$15.00 for one hour (\$60 per month)



ADULTS CLASSES

Ladies DanceFit - \$13 per class

To attend this classes, you must purchase a 10 week pass for \$130 and it will be valid for 6 months from date of purchase. The pass must be brought to each lesson so that attendance can be marked.

CONCERT BUNDLE

We want to make the end of year concert experience as simple as possible for all our families. Parents can relax knowing all of the costumes, photos and recordings will be ordered and ready for you. All students that perform in the concert will receive all digital group and individual photos. The concert bundle fee also includes a high resolution video download of the concert and the dress/technical rehearsals costs. **This fee will be paid over 2 instalments in September and October.** More details on 2024 pricing will be provided throughout the year.

CONCERT COSTUMES

Your child's costume will be organized and ready for you to collect at the studio the week prior to our Dress Rehearsal. The cost of your costume includes; measuring, materials, dressmaking, shipping, accessories, hair accessories AND you get to keep your costume. The costume costs are outlined below. The cost will be split into 3 payments due in June, July and August. The costume charge will be added to your account and emailed to families prior to payment being deducted.

**There are no refunds as costumes are ordered well in advance.

FEE PAYMENT

Payments for fees, costumes and concert bundles are automatically debited through AUTOPAY for all families. Invoices are emailed out prior to the amount being debited. Parents are welcome at any stage to make payments on your account via the portal before the Autopay is run.

There will be 40 weeks of dancing in 2024 and these 40 weeks will be divided into 10 equal monthly payments. First payment will be due on 1st February and the last on 1st November.

AUTOPAY

Fees will be deducted from your bank account or credit card using an ezidebit payment system. What to expect with AUTOPAY:

- You will receive an emailed invoice prior to fees being deducted.
- On the 1st business day of the month fees will be deducted.
- It is important that you keep sufficient funds in your account to cover your monthly payment if your autopay fails, we will rerun again in two days time.
- 1.95% merchant fee for use of credit cards

Important: With the rise of identity theft, the laws have become very strict regarding how and where you store your financial information. Our online Portal—'Dance Studio Pro' does not store any financial information on our servers and is a violation of our terms of use for any dance studio to store financial information within their accounts. All financial details such as credit card numbers or bank accounts will be stored within a compliant merchant processor.

CEASING AT YOUR REQUEST

The office requires <u>4 week's notice</u> of your child's intention to discontinue classes. Fees are charged up to and including the 4-week notification period whether the child attends or not. If you choose to cancel your enrollment, we require you to fill out a cancellation form that you can access from our website. If we do not receive a cancellation form, fees will continue to be deducted.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

We do not run classes on public holidays. You will not be charged for public holidays if there is no make-up class for it. However, for those students on a class package fee, fees are NOT adjusted for public holidays, and your regular monthly deposit continues.

Uniform is **COMPULSORY** for all students aged 12 years and under. Students may choose to wear any style from our 'DP UNIFORM' selection that is suitable for the class (e.g. DP leotard for ballet, ruffle set or skirt and mesh singlet for jazz etc.). Senior and Open students are encouraged to wear suitable dancewear.

Uniforms and merchandise can be purchased via our online ordering system. For further information on what we have available, costs of uniform and what your child is required to wear for class visit www.dancepower.com.au

We will have plenty of stock at our open day on the 27th January so if you would like to pre order via the website we can set it aside for you to collect.

Ballet Uniform:

- Junior grades (Grade 2 and Grade 3) these students MUST wear a DP leotard with pink ballet stockings and pink ballet shoes. Hair must be in a NEAT bun.
- Senior grades (Pre-elementary/ Elementary) plain black leotard with pink ballet stockings.
 Hair must be in a NEAT bun.

Shoes:

- Mini Groovers Ballet- pink canvas ballet shoes
- Mini Groovers Jazz and Acro- pink canvas ballet shoes
- Lil Kidz, Junior, Junior/Intermediate- tan jazz shoes, tan tap shoes
- Intermediate/Senior, Senior and Opens- black jazz shoes, black tap shoes
- Lil kidz, Junior, Junior/Intermediate Lyrical, pink canvas ballet shoes
- Intermediate/Senior, Senior and Open lyrical- tan free forms

Note:

- *jazz shoes can be split sole
- *ballet shoes need to be leather and split sole
- *tap shoes are preferred to be Velcro for junior age groups
- *tap shoes for Int/Sen/Open age groups are to be lace up
